- Which of the following sentences uses the correct **pronoun**?
  - We want to see us tomorrow.
  - We want to see they tomorrow.

- Which of the following sentences uses the correct **pronoun**?
  - I went to the zoo with her.
  - I went to the zoo with she.
  - I went to the zoo with they.

10. Which of the following sentences uses the correct **pronoun**?

Answer 1: B

HINT 1: If you cover the other person's name, the rest of the sentence should still sound like we talk. If it doesn't, it is incorrect. Eg. Sally and me ran to the mall. Sally and me ran to the mall. "Me ran to the mall." doesn't sound right or make sense. Sally and I ran to the mall. Sally and I ran to the mall. "I ran to the mall." still sounds right and makes sense.

HINT 2: NEVER put yourself before your friend or another person. To be polite, you should always state the other person's name or pronoun in front of your own name or pronoun. Eg. "Me and him are going to play ball." should be, "He and I are going to play ball." "John and me are going to play ball." should be "John and I are going to play ball." Use the same trick as above where you cover up the other person's name and the word "and" but also switch "are" to am to see if it sounds like a big kid or adult talking.
