Once you've seen a picture of it you can't forget it, because with its columns and marble arches, the white tower looks like a spectacular wedding cake that has been knocked askew by accident! To this day, no one knows the name of the person who designed it. The tower was straight when it was built, but until 1990 it leaned at a 10 degree angle because the foundation was not sufficient to keep the building perfectly stable. Many efforts over the years have been made to keep the tower from leaning any further; consequently it is now slightly bowed. In the 1920s the foundation was ejected with a stabilizing concrete grouting which helped
