A biography is the story of a person's life. When a person does something significant—politically, socially, scientifically, culturally, artistically, athletically, etc.—people usually want to know more about them. A biography tells more than just the basics facts about a person. It also tells the reader how the subject of the biography feels or felt about his or her life. Biographies often include personal details about the relationships the subject had, and sometimes analyzes the subject's personality, and comments upon how the subject was affected by the times in which he or she lived.
