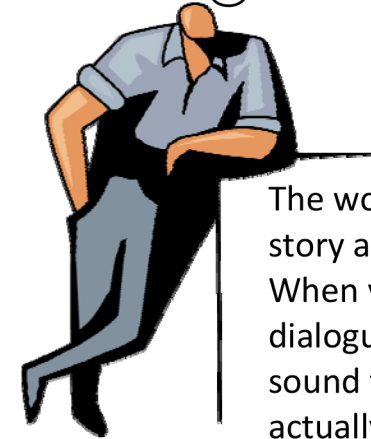

Revealing Character Through Dialogue
