- Line 1 First name of the person
- Line 2 Three or four character traits of the person
- Line 3 An important relationship or relationships of the person
- Line 4 Three or four things or people the person loves or loved
- Line 5 Three or four feelings the person has or had
- Line 6 Three or four fears the person has or had
- Line 7 Three or four things the person needs or needed
- Line 8 Three or four things the person has given
- Line 9 Three or four things the person wants or wanted
- Line 10 Where the person lives or lived
- Line 11 Last name of the person
